We have carefully perused the contents of the review petition.

We find no merit therein.

The fact stated in para 6 of the review petition was never

brought to the notice of nor urged before the Court. Even if urged, it

would have had no merit. It is unfortunate to note the petitioner making

a desperate attempt at digging out a ground for review petition and that too by seeking discharge of the Advocate-on-Record who had filed the Writ Petition and had continued to appear for it till the end. The prayer is refused.

In the Writ Petition, there was nothing on facts; only neat questions of law involving interpretation of constitutional and legal provisions were raised which were answered and the petition was disposed of. We do not find any error in the view taken therein.

The review petition is dismissed as devoid of any merit.
