"(a) Issue writ of mandamus/writs order to the Union of India/or the authorities concerned to perform their Constitutional duty under Article 32 read with Articles 21 and 14 of the Constitution of India in releasing the pension of the petitioners direction them to discharge their constitutional obligation."
