O R D E R

1. Petitioners challenge the judgment and order dated 18.09.2025 in Application U/s 482 No.33808/2024 passed by the High Court of Judicature at Allahabad, titled "*Satish Yadav Alias Babloo & Ors. vs. State of U.P. & Anr.*".
2. Delay condoned.
3. We have heard learned counsel for the petitioners.
4. *Prima facie*, it appears that the dispute is primarily

between the landlord and the tenant. The tenant has not paid the rent as demanded by the landlord and, as a counter-blast thereof, the tenant has initiated proceedings under different provisions of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 against the landlord.

5. Issue notice, returnable on 24.04.2026.

6. Ms. Ruchira Goel, learned counsel, accepts notice on behalf of respondent no.1/State. Hence, the formal service of notice on the said respondent is waived.

7. Learned counsel for the petitioner to serve a copy of the present petition to the learned counsel for respondent no.1 within a period of one (01) week.

8. Let counter affidavit be filed within three (03) weeks. Rejoinder affidavit thereto, if any, be filed before the next date of listing.

9. We make it clear that no further opportunity will be granted for this purpose.

10. In the notice itself let it be mentioned that the respondent no.2 is required to file the counter affidavit and reply to the interlocutory application(s), if any, before the next date of listing.

11. In the meanwhile, there shall not be coercive action against the petitioners.
