Upon hearing the counsel the Court made the following

O R D E R

1. Petitioner challenges the judgment and order dated 23.12.2025 in MAT.APP.(F.C) No.370/2023 passed by the High Court of Delhi at New Delhi, titled "*Suranjan Saha vs. Rumpa Saha*".

2. Delay condoned.
3. Issue notice only for the purpose of exploring the possibility of settlement.
4. Mr. Nitesh Ranjan, learned counsel, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent. Hence, the formal service of notice on the respondent is waived.
5. Heard learned counsel on both sides. The submissions reveal the desire of the parties to explore the possibility of a mediated settlement.
6. In such circumstances, the parties are directed to appear before the Coordinator, Supreme Court Mediation Center on 09.04.2026 at 11.00 a.m. The Coordinator shall appoint a Mediator to enable the parties to make an effort to settle the matter amicably.
7. Initially, the parties are permitted to appear virtually and thereafter, the parties shall appear as per the directions of the Mediator.
8. If the learned Mediator requires the physical presence of the respondent/wife, then the travel, lodging and boarding expenses of her shall be borne by the petitioner/husband.
9. List the matter along with Mediation Report on 14.07.2026.
10. In the meanwhile, the petitioner shall also comply with the directions issued by the Courts below.
