Appellant was convicted under Section 395 of the Indian Penal Code and sentenced to seven years R.I. He filed an appeal before the High Court of Delhi against the order of his conviction and sentence which has been admitted but he has not been released on bail during the pendency of the appeal. It is stated at the Bar that the appellant has already undergone four years of imprisonment and there is no likelihood of appeal being heard at an early stage.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, we direct that the appellant shall be released on bail during the pendency of the appeal upon furnishing bail bond in the amount of Rs. 25,000/- with two sureties of the like amount and his personal bond to the satisfaction of the trial court.
