UPON hearing counsel the Court made the following
ORDER

It is accepted at the Bar that after the impugned judgment was passed by the High Court, the accused-respondents have been acquitted by the learned trial Judge. The State of Punjab has not preferred any appeal thereagainst. The petitioners have, however, filed a Revision Application against the said judgment of acquittal wherein, we are informed, notices have been directed to be issued. If that be so, the petitioners as complainants can point out to the High Court the order of the State Government as also the report of the Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur, Punjab so as to enable the High Court to pass an appropriate order thereupon in accordance with law.

We may place on record that Mr. Bhagat, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents contends that a Civil suit as also another writ petition have been filed by the petitioners.

The High Court is requested to consider the desirability of disposing of the Criminal Revision Application as expeditiously as possible as according to the learned counsel for the petitioners they have been dispossessed from the factory premises as far back as in the year 1995.

All contentions of the parties shall remain open.
