O R D E R

1. Permission to file special leave petition is granted.
2. We have heard learned counsel for the petitioners and perused the record.

3. It seems to us that the liberty granted by this Court *vide* order dated 05.01.2026 in SLP(C) No.34/2026 provides sufficient protection to the aggrieved villagers/Gram Panchayats to approach the Competent Authority for safeguarding their constitutional rights.

4. In view of the above, no further interference is warranted in the impugned order passed by the High Court of Judicature for Rajasthan at Jaipur.

5. The Special Leave Petitions are, accordingly, disposed of.
