O R D E R

We refuse permission to the petitioner to file the Special Leave Petition on behalf of her husband, who is an accused in a criminal case pending trial. Moreover we notice that the High Court by its impugned order dated 21st April, 2005, while dismissing the transfer petition, gave opportunity to the accused to cross-examine the investigating officer. That being so, on the next date when the accused is produced before the Court concerned, he can move the trial court to summon the investigating officer for cross-examination. Apparently, therefore, the apprehension that the Trial Judge will pronounce the judgment on 25th April, 2005 is not well founded.
