O R D E R

1. We are not inclined to interfere with the impugned judgment and order of the High Court; hence, the special leave petition is dismissed.

2. However, considering the fact that the petitioner is due to write the High School Examination (Class 12), which is scheduled between 18th to 27th February 2026, we direct him to be released on interim bail, subject to such terms and conditions to be imposed by the trial court. However, immediately after the examination is over, on 1st March 2026, to be precised, the petitioner will have to surrender, failing which the law enforcement agency shall be at liberty to take appropriate steps against him in accordance with law.
