O R D E R

Aggrieved against the order of the Labour Court, the petitioner filed a writ
petition in

the High Court. Before the Single Judge, it was conceded by both the parties that the ratio o
f this

Court's decision in the case of Bank of Baroda vs. Ghemarbhai Harjibhai Rabari [(2005) 10 SCC

792] was fully applicable to the facts of the present case and Writ Petition may
be disposed in

terms of the said decision.

Accordingly, the Single Judge dismissed the writ petition in terms of the above decision

of this Court. Review Application was also dismissed. Thereafter the petitioner filed Letters

Patent Appeal. The Division Bench, without going into the merits of the case, dismissed the LP A

as the counsel for the petitioner had conceded before the Single Judge that the dispute was

covered by the above decision of this Court.

As the order was passed on a concession made, leaving the questions of law open, the

Special Leave Petition is dismissed.
