O R D E R

This petition seeks leave to appeal against an order of the High Court rejecting an application under Section 389 Cr.P.C. for suspension of sentence during the pendency of the appeal. From a perusal of the judgment, we find that the appeal is a short one and may not take much time in being heard. The High Court may expedite the hearing of appeal and dispose of the same finally at an early date. The petitioner is allowed liberty of approaching the High Court seeking an early date for hearing in the appeal. If the appeal is not heard within a period of two months, we allow the petitioner liberty of approaching the High Court with a fresh application for suspension of sentence which shall be heard and decided on its own merits uninfluenced by the earlier rejection of the application. The special leave petition be treated as disposed of in the terms above-said.
