UPON hearing counsel the Court made the following

O R D E R

The application filed in SLP(C)...CC Nos. 8381-8382/2013 to file special leave petition(s) is allowed in terms of the prayer made.

Applications for condonation of delay and substitution are allowed.

These petitions are directed against order dated 26.11.2012 passed by the Division Bench of Karnataka High Court whereby the

writ appeals filed by the respondent no.1 were allowed and the order passed by the learned Single Judge quashing the acquisition of the petitioners' land was set aside.

After making submissions for a while, learned counsel for the petitioners requested that their respective clients to be permitted to withdraw the special leave petitions with liberty to seek review of the judgment under challenge.

The request of the learned counsel is accepted and the special leave petitions are dismissed as withdrawn.

If the review petitions are not entertained by the High Court, the petitioners shall be free to file fresh special leave petitions. In that event they shall be entitled to challenge the order impugned in these petitions.
