O R D E RSLP(C) Nos. 4785-4786/2013

The learned counsel for the sole respondent has stated that he will file the counter affidavit today itself. Learned counsel Mr. Balbir Singh Gupta shall serve the copy of the counter affidavit to Mr. A.P. Mayee, Id. Counsel within a weeks time.

SLP(C) Nos. 8321-8327/2013

What gets revealed from the perusal of the file is that although two opportunities have already been given to the respondent No. 1 for filing the counter affidavit, yet he has not done the needful so far. Therefore no further opportunity is warranted to be given to him on that count taking into consideration the rule position.

Fresh steps for the service of notice to the unserved respondent No. 2 shall be taken by the learned counsel for the petitioners within a period of three weeks.

SLP(C) Nos. 16007-16012/2013

The office report is that the sole respondent in SLP(C) No.16007/2013 has filed the counter affidavit which is found to be defective. The learned counsel shall rectify the defects whatever have been found in the said counter affidavit within a period of two weeks.

Four weeks time, as last chance is given to the learned counsel for the petitioners to take fresh steps for the service of notice to the unserved respondents. The served respondents shall be at liberty to file the counter affidavit within a period of four weeks, in case they intend to do so.

SLP(C) No. 18312/2013

The office report indicates that an application for substitution of deceased respondent has been filed on 24.2.2014 by the learned counsel for the petitioners and the same is defective. The learned counsel is directed to cure the defects whatever have been found in the said application within a period of two weeks.
