UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R

1. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that a conditional order was passed by this Court on 05.01.2026 which reads, thus:

*"As prayed, two weeks' further time is granted to the learned counsel for the petitioner to file proof of surrender, failing which the Special Leave Petition shall be dismissed in default."*

2. Learned counsel submits that though the petitioner, in pursuance to order dated 05.01.2026, surrendered himself to the

competent authority within the stipulated time i.e. 17.01.2026 but, for a couple of days delay in submitting necessary intimation to this Court, the Special Leave Petition stood dismissed in view of conditional order.

3. Learned counsel draws attention of this Court to the document placed on record annexed to the application at Annexure P-2 (page No.10). Perusal of this document namely the Order of the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Jalandhar dated 17.01.2026 clearly show that the petitioner Palwinder Singh surrendered himself on 17.01.2026 and he was sent to the Central Jail, Kapurthala, Jalandhar.

4. In view of the above recorded facts and particularly, the document annexed as Annexure P-2, the application for restoration is allowed.

5. The Special Leave Petition is restored to its original number.
