UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R

1. Mr. C.M.Angadi, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner submits that liberty may be given to implead the family members of the deceased. Learned counsel prays for substitution of sentence with that of an order for payment of compensation.
2. Liberty to implead the family members of the deceased.
3. Let amended memo of parties be filed.
4. Issue notice to the State as well as the newly impleaded parties, returnable on 25<sup>th</sup> May, 2026.
5. The newly impleaded parties may be served through the Station House Officer, Kulagod Police Station, Mudalgi,

Belagavi District, Karnataka.

6. Liberty to serve dasti.

7. In the meantime, the order dated 27.02.2026 granting exemption from surrendering to the petitioner shall continue to operate subject to the petitioner appearing before the Trial Court concerned and executing a bond for Rupees Ten thousand with two sureties of the like amount.

8. Let an affidavit of compliance be filed before this Court within a period of two weeks.

9. Post the matter on 25<sup>th</sup> May, 2026.
