O R D E R

1. This petition has been filed by the petitioner-wife seeking transfer of petition bearing No.2111/2022 titled as "*Deepak Mishra Vs. Ichchha Upadhyay*", pending before the Court of Principal Judge, Family Court, Varanasi, Uttar Pradesh to the Family Court, Bandra, Mumbai, Maharashtra.
2. None has entered appearance on behalf of the respondent in spite of service of notice.
3. Having heard learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, we are inclined to transfer the case sought for. We, accordingly, allow the transfer petition and direct that the petition bearing No.2111/2022 titled as "*Deepak Mishra Vs. Ichchha Upadhyay*", pending before the Court of Principal Judge, Family Court, Varanasi, Uttar Pradesh be transferred to the Family Court, Bandra, Mumbai, Maharashtra.
4. However, if the video conferencing facility is available with the Court, the benefit of the same shall be extended to the parties, unless their physical presence is required.
5. The transferor Court shall forthwith transmit the record of the aforesaid case to the transferee court.

6. The transferee Court shall make all possible endeavours first for an amicable settlement between the parties, failing which for early decision in the matter without unnecessary adjournments.
