Issue notice.

2. No formal notice be sent to the respondent as Mr. Amol Chitale, learned Advocate, who appears on caveat, accepts notice on his behalf.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that after five years, the prayer for visitation rights have been re-agitated when already it had been consented to by the respondent not to do so at the time of final settlement between the parties before the Trial Court. However, he submits that the matter be referred to mediation.

4. Learned counsel for the respondent submits that the respondent is agreeable to mediation. However, a request is made to send it to the Mediation Centre of the Madras High Court at Chennai.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioner agrees to the same.

6. Accordingly, the matter is referred to the Mediation Centre of the Madras High Court, Principal Bench, Chennai.

7. Parties to initially appear physically before the Mediation Centre of the Madras High Court on 21.04.2026 at 02:00 p.m.

8. Learned Mediator is requested to submit a report within two months thereafter.

9. List on 28.07.2026.

10. In the meantime, to facilitate the mediation, all *inter se* proceedings pending between the parties shall remain stayed.
