O R D E R

In these petitions, the petitioner has prayed for transfer of Original Suit No. 38 of 2013 filed by the respondent for grant of divorce and Miscellaneous Case No.10 of 2013 filed by her for award of maintenance from the Family Court at Meerut to the Court of Principal District Judge, Nashik within the State of Maharashtra.

While issuing notice of the transfer petitions on 18.4.2013, this Court referred the parties to the Mediation Centre of the Supreme Court to explore the possibility of an amicable settlement of their matrimonial disputes.

The report sent by the Mediation Centre shows that the parties have settled their disputes and have executed Settlement Agreement dated 21.6.2013.

The Settlement Agreement filed by the parties is taken on record. The same shall be treated as a part of this order.

In view of the above development, the transfer petitions are disposed of as infructuous. However, as agreed by learned counsel for the parties, the Settlement Agreement is modified in the following terms:

- i) Instead of depositing a sum of Rs.1,00,00,000/- (rupees one crore) in the Registry of this Court, the petitioner shall handover drafts of Rs.68,00,000/-(rupees sixty eight lacs) to the respondent through her counsel. The needful has been done in the Court.
- ii) The petitioner shall deposit FDRs of Rs.32,00,000/- (rupees thirty two lacs) in the trial Court, which shall pass appropriate order for disbursement of the amount at the time of disposal of the petition filed by the parties under Section 13B of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955.
