We are not inclined to interfere with the impugned order inasmuch the High Court is taking up the matter for hearing again on 20.7.2001. However, in view of submissions made on behalf of the petitioner State and

after hearing the learned counsel for the respondent it is clarified that the impugned orders dated 11.4.2001 and 22.5.2001 passed by the High Court shall not come in the way of the State and its officials proceeding under the U.P. Gangsters and Anti-social Activities (Prevention) Act, 1986 (Act. No. 7/1986) subject to compliance with the provisions of law. The learned counsel for the respondent expressed an apprehension at this stage that the police may harass the respondent and his family members. The learned counsel for the petitioner states that there is no reason for any such apprehension as the authorities of the State shall act strictly in accordance with law. The petitions are disposed of. The High Court shall proceed to hear this matter uninfluenced by this order while adjudicating upon the matter finally.
