UPON hearing counsel the Court made the following
ORDER

We find no ground for interference under Article 136 of the
Constitution of India.

However, learned counsel for the petitioner voices an
apprehension that the observation in the judgment of the High Court
may be read as exclusion of Rahimthang from consideration.

We have gone through the order of the High Court. There is
no direction that while considering the location, Rahimthang should
be excluded from consideration. On the other hand, we find that the
direction is that the Government should ascertain the suitable location
of the headquarters for the new block, in the best interest of justice. As
such, the apprehension of the petitioner is without any basis.

The special leave petitions are dismissed.
