O R D E R

This Special Leave Petition is directed against the orders passed by  
the learned Single Judge of the High Court of Kerala at Ernakulam in Writ  
Petition (Civil)No.1549 of 2013, dated 26.02.2013.

In our view, if, for any reason, the petitioner is aggrieved by the  
aforesaid order, he has to file a Writ Appeal before the very same High  
Court. Bypassing that remedy, in our opinion, the petitioner should not  
have approached this Court.

In that view of the matter, we decline to entertain this petition.  
However, we permit the petitioner to file a Writ Appeal before the very  
same High Court within a week's time from today, if the petitioner is so  
desired. If such a petition is filed within the time granted by us, we  
request the High Court to dispose of the appeal as expeditiously as  
possible.

All the contentions of the petitioner are left open.  
Ordered accordingly.
