the following  
O R D E R

1. The High Court has denied regular bail to the petitioner in connection with FIR No.11216024240379 of 2024 registered with Kalol city Police Station, District Gandhinagar, for the offence punishable under Sections 8(C) and 22 (C) of the Narcotics Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, respectively (for short, "the NDPS Act").
2. We heard Mr. Rahul Narang, the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner and Ms. Sonakshi Sinha, the learned counsel appearing for the State of Gujarat.
3. The trial is in progress. So far, two (02) witnesses have been examined. The prosecution intends to examine as many as twelve witnesses.
4. We also take notice of the fact that the petitioner is in jail since 24.08.2024. What is important for us to take notice is that the

recovery of the contraband was from the possession of the co-accused.

5. *Prima-facie*, it appears that the petitioner herein was arrested on the basis of the statement/ confession made by the co-accused.

6. Since the trial is in progress, we should not observe anything further.

7. The petitioner is ordered to be released on bail subject to terms and conditions that the Trial Court may deem fit to impose.

8. With the aforesaid, the Special Leave Petition stands disposed of.

9. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
