UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

1. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioner - wife.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the marriage between the petitioner - wife and the respondent - husband was solemnized on 03.06.2016 and the couple was blessed with one girl child. The approach of the respondent - husband towards matrimonial relationship was casual and negligent and the respondent used to ill-treat the petitioner - wife on small issues. The petitioner was also subjected to physical violence at some times as such she was constrained to leave her matrimonial home and resided at her parental home at Medchal Malkajgiri District, Telangana. The petitioner who is medical professional is required to attend the hospital and provides medical service to the patients. Considering these peculiar circumstances, the petitioner is unable to attend

the proceedings initiated at the instance of the respondent at Thane, Maharashtra. The distance between these two places is approximately 758 Kms. On these grounds, the petitioner is before this Court. Learned counsel also submits that the petitioner is having no hesitation to explore the possibility of amicable settlement between the parties in case the respondent - husband appears before this Court and shows his willingness.

3. Issue notice, returnable within four weeks.

4. In the meantime, there shall be stay of further proceedings bearing M.P. No.261/2025, titled as "Mr. Srinivas Kandagatla Vs. Mrs. Soniya Srinivas Kandagatla", pending before the Civil Judge, Senior Division at Thane, Maharashtra.
