In this petition filed under Section 25 of the Code of Civil Procedure, the petitioner has prayed for transfer of H.M.A. No.65 of 2012 titled Rajesh v. Pratibha filed by the respondent under Section 13(1)(ia)(iii) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 which is pending in the Court of Principal Judge, Family Court, Nagpur within the State of Maharashtra to the Family Court, Saket, New Delhi.

The petitioner has sought transfer on the grounds of financial difficulty and her inability to travel between Delhi and Nagpur for attending proceedings of the case filed by the respondent.

Notice of the transfer petition has been duly served upon the respondent but neither he nor any one else has appeared on his behalf and no counter has been filed to controvert the averments contained in the transfer petition.
