**O R D E R**

1. Leave granted.
2. Heard learned counsel for the parties.
3. This appeal arises from an order dated 19.01.2026 passed by the High Court of Punjab and Haryana at Chandigarh rejecting the anticipatory bail prayer of the appellant in connection with FIR No. 106/2025, registered at Sector 34, District Chandigarh.
4. After considering the submissions of learned counsel for the appellant, on 26.02.2026, we had granted interim

protection in the following terms:

"1. Issue notice, returnable in six weeks.

2. In the meantime, it is provided that in the event the Petitioner is arrested in connection with FIR No. 106/2025 registered at P.S. Sector 34, District Chandigarh, he shall be released on a personal bond of Rs. 25,000/- subject to an undertaking that he shall cooperate in the investigation and make himself available for interrogation as and when required by the investigating agency. He shall also submit an undertaking that he will not threaten the witnesses or tamper the evidence."

5. On service of notice, the State is represented.

6. It is not shown that the appellant is not cooperating in the investigation.

7. Having regard to the nature of the allegations, we deem it appropriate to dispose of this appeal by making the interim order absolute, subject to the following

**conditions:**

- a) Within three weeks from today, the appellant shall submit bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Trial Court along with an undertaking that he shall co-operate in the trial/investigation; and
  
- b) He shall submit an additional undertaking that he will not threaten the witnesses or tamper the evidence.

8. Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
