On the basis of a complaint, proceedings under Section 420 of the Indian Penal Code having been initiated, the accused filed an application for quashing of the cognizance. The High Court having rejected the same, the accused is before this Court. Though Mr. R.K. Jain, learned senior counsel contended that the allegations do not make out an offence under Section 420 IPC and the dispute is one of a civil nature, but, having regard to the facts and circumstances, he offered to pay Rs.1,50,000/-, in addition to the sum of Rs.65,000/-, which has already been deposited/paid to the complainant. The sum of Rs.1,50,000/- is paid in Court to the counsel for the complainant.
