After having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and perusal of the record, we are of the considered opinion that no case for interference against the impugned order is made out. Special leave
petition is accordingly dismissed.

Petitioner was already granted time upto 16.2.2012 to vacate and handover peaceful possession of the suit premises to the respondent.

However, looking to the facts and features of the case and keeping in mind that the petitioner has been carrying on business in the suit premises for a considerable time, petitioner is granted further time of six months from 17.2.2012 to vacate and handover peaceful and vacant possession of the suit premises to Respondent-decree holder, subject to its filing usual undertaking in this Court within four weeks from today.
