ORDER

The petitioner has filed the present transfer petition seeking transfer of Case No.18533 of 2007 arising out of FIR No.77 of 2007 titled as Tanu Chaudhary v. Ajay Katara pending before the Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ghaziabad to the court of competent jurisdiction at Delhi.

This Court issued notice on 21.4.2008 and stayed further proceedings in Case No.18533 of 2007 pending in the Court of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Ghaziabad arising out of FIR Crime No.77 of 2007.

Learned counsel appearing for respondent No.2 submits that he has no objection if the matter is transferred to any other Court except Delhi.

We have heard learned counsel for the parties.
