UPON hearing counsel the Court made the following

O R D E R

In this petition filed under Article 32 of the Constitution, the petitioners have made the following substantive prayers:

"a) To issue an appropriate writ, order or direction in the nature of mandamus directing the Respondent NDMC to handover to the Petitioners their respective allotted tehbazari/vending site as per the draw of lot held on 10.05.2012 pursuant to the Order dated 1.5.2012 passed by this Hon'ble Court and accept the registration charges and tehbazari fee in respect of the same, subject to such further order (s) as may be passed by this Hon'ble Court; or in the alternative

b) Direct the Respondent NDMC to accept the registration charges and tehbazari fee from the petitioners in respect of their present vending site as mentioned in Annexure P-8."

After making submissions for a while and realising that this Court is not inclined to entertain the statement made, without any basis, that despite the interim order passed by this Court, the respondent is harassing the petitioners, learned senior counsel for the petitioners made a request that his clients may be permitted to withdraw the writ petition.

The request of the learned senior counsel is accepted and the writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
