UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

We are not inclined to interfere with the impugned order(s) passed by the High Court.

The petitioner-Northerncoalfields Limited shall undertake a fresh exercise for tender, as directed by the High Court, and complete the same within a period of two months from today.

In the meantime, since the work order has already been issued to the petitioner-Harsh Roadlines Private Limited (petitioner in the connected special leave petition), in order to ensure continuous supply and transactions of coal, we provide that Harsh Roadlines Private Limited shall be permitted to continue operations until the fresh tender is finalised or for a period of two months from today, which ever is earlier.

It is made clear that no equity shall be created in favour of Harsh Roadlines Private Limited by virtue of this interim arrangement of two months.

With the aforesaid observations, the special leave petitions and pending applications stand disposed of.
