O R D E R

1. We have perused the review petition and the materials available on record.
2. The review petitioners, who were not parties to Civil Appeal No 316 of 2026 and Civil Appeal No. 317 of 2026, have sought clarification of observations/ directions given, particularly, in paragraph 74 of our judgment and order dated 12.01.2026 passed in the aforesaid appeals.
3. In paragraph 74, we had directed that no further application(s) or petition(s) either by the appellants or by the judgment debtor i.e. respondent No. 2 or by any other person claiming right *qua* the suit property

through them shall be entertained by any court.

4. Our direction is sufficiently clear and has been issued to ensure that frivolous objection to execution of the decree be not raised either by the parties bound by the decree or by anyone claiming through them. We, therefore, do not find a good reason to entertain this review petition filed by a non-party to the appeals.

5. Consequently, the review petition is dismissed.

6. All applications shall stand disposed of in terms of this order.
