O R D E R

1. Delay in filing the spare copies is condoned.

2. We have heard the learned senior counsel appearing for the petitioner and the learned counsel appearing for both the respondents.

The Petitioner has been the granted benefit of interim protection that no coercive steps be taken against him in connection with the FIR No.145/2025, registered with Police Station-Bahawala, Tehsil-Abohar, District-Fazilka for the offences punishable under Sections-316(2) and 318(4) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023
