UPON hearing the counsel the
Court made the following
O R D E R

1. Heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the material placed on record.
2. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the period of incarceration undergone by the petitioner, i.e. since 29.08.2024 and the fact that the main allegations of supplying the poisonous substance are against the

husband of the deceased and the petitioner herein is mother-in-law, we are inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

3. Accordingly, in the facts and circumstances of the case, we direct that the petitioner be released on bail on such terms and conditions as may be imposed by the Trial Court in connection with FIR No. 314 dated 20.09.2022, registered at Police Station Sadar Ballabgarh, District Faridabad, Haryana.

4. It goes without saying that the petitioner will

extend all co-operation during the investigation/trial.

5. In the event the Trial Court or the State finds that the petitioner is delaying the conclusion of trial, it will be open for them to approach this Court for recall of this order.

6. The Special Leave Petition and pending application(s) are disposed of accordingly.
