O R D E R

1. Permission to appear and argue in person is granted.
2. In this writ petition under Article 32 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner challenges an FIR. He also seeks other relief not connected with the FIR.
3. We find multiple causes of action having been joined in a single petition. When queried as to why he has not moved the High Court under Article 226 of

the Constitution, the petitioner submits that the High Court has rejected his writ petition.

4. The order of rejection is not the subject matter of the challenge.

5. In such view of the matter, we find no reason to entertain this writ petition under Article 32 of the Constitution of India; hence the same is dismissed.

5. However, this order of dismissal shall not preclude the petitioner to challenge the order of rejection and/or to claim other relief before an appropriate forum in accordance of law.
