3. Mr. N. Venkataraman, upon instructions, submitted that the Department has been levying Excise Duty on the same activity, besides States collecting VAT. Now, Service tax is sought to be imposed on the same value of goods, crushing and transportation charges. This will be a double levy of both Excise Duty and Service tax on the same transaction.
4. In view of the aforesaid, this Appeal stands dismissed.
5. Pending applications also stand disposed of.
