UPON hearing counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R

S.L.P. (Crl.) No.7056 of 2012, has been filed against the judgment and order of the Kerala High Court dated 31st January, 2012, reversing the judgment of the Trial Court holding the petitioner not guilty of the offence under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act.

Now it transpires that in terms of the order of the High Court, the petitioner has already paid the entire amount, as indicated, to the respondent. An application for compounding the offence has since been filed by the parties. Having heard learned counsel for the parties and having perused the application for compounding the offence, we allow the same.

The offence alleged shall stand compounded and the petitioner shall stand acquitted of the charges against him in terms of the provisions of Section 320(8) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

The special leave petition is disposed of accordingly.
