UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

Arising out of the order passed by the High Court dated
30.08.2022 in Writ C No. 1003391 of 2015, contempt
proceedings have been filed which is the subject matter of this
case.

It is informed that Special Appeal against the order
dated 30.08.2022 passed in Writ C No. 1003391 of 2015 is

pending and on filing of the application by the petitioner, hearing has been deferred till 28.03.2024 by the contempt Court.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, we dispose of these special leave petitions with the observation that hearing of the contempt matter may be deferred and it will be proceeded subject to outcome of Special Appeal bearing No. 15/2024 (Defective). The defect, if any, be rectified within a week by the appellant.

Considering the peculiar facts and circumstances of the case as observed by the learned Single Judge *vide* order dated 06.03.2024 in the last paragraph, we request the Division Bench of the High Court to decide the application for condonation of delay/appeal, as the case may be, as early as possible, and preferably, within a period of three months.

The special leave petitions stand disposed of.
