Leave granted.

Heard learned counsel for the parties.

It is stated that the alleged occurrence is dated 03.05.2017. However, the First Information Report was registered on 09.05.2017, after the death of Uttam Shankar Mullak (deceased) on 08.05.2017. Medico-legal case was not recorded when the deceased was taken to the hospital. The Police had earlier filed a closure report in Form-A. Lastly, three co-accused have been granted bail.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, we accept the present appeal and direct that the appellant - Parmeshwar Shrirang Shelke will be released on bail during the pendency of the trial in the case arising out of First Information Report/Crime No. 86 of 2017 dated 09.05.2017 registered with Police Station - Ambad, District - Jalna, Maharashtra for the offence(s) punishable under Sections 302, 504, 506 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 on terms and conditions to be fixed by the trial court.

The appellant - Parmeshwar Shrirang Shelke will personally attend the hearings before the trial court unless he is granted exemption from personal appearance.

The appellant - Parmeshwar Shrirang Shelke will provide one mobile number on which he can be contacted by the Investigating Officer/Station House Officer of the concerned police station to ascertain his whereabouts.

The impugned judgment is set aside and the appeal is allowed in the aforesaid terms.

We clarify that the observations made in this order are for disposal of the present appeal, and grant of bail will not be treated as findings on the merits of the case.
