UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

The complainant has come up before this Court seeking setting aside of order dated 10.02.2025, by which the High Court has granted bail to the accused - Respondent No. 2, who is a 60-year old woman, on the ground that there is evidence that Respondent No.2 was not present at the place of the incident at the relevant point of time. However, this was a *prima facie* view and relevant

only for the purpose of grant of bail.

In any case, we do not see any justification to interfere with the order of the High Court dated 10.02.2025, by which the bail has been granted. Nevertheless, we dispose of this Special Leave Petition with a direction that the trial be concluded as expeditiously as possible, preferably within six months from today and if required, a day-to-day hearing be conducted, without granting any unnecessary adjournments to either of the parties.

It is made clear that in case the Trial Court is of the opinion that the respondent is abusing the process of law or the bail which has been granted to her, the petitioner will be at liberty to approach this Court.

In view of above, the Special Leave Petition is disposed of.
