UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R

By order dated 17.02.2021 this Court had directed the petitioner to vacate the premises in question within eight weeks and costs of Rs. 1 lakh was imposed.

This application has been filed to grant a further period of eight weeks for compliance of the said order.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioner/applicant and considering the facts of the case, we are not satisfied that

any further time should be given. But considering the pandemic situation, we grant further one month's time from today to the petitioner/applicant to vacate the premises in question, subject to deposit of a sum of Rs. 1 lakh towards costs with the Registry of this Court within two weeks from today. On deposit of such amount, the respondent shall be entitled to withdraw the same.

It is further made clear that in case the possession is not delivered to the respondent within one month from today i.e. by 7<sup>th</sup> June, 2021, the petitioner shall be liable for contempt of orders of this Court.

The Miscellaneous Applications stand disposed of accordingly.
