O R D E R

1. The delay of 60 days in filing the present petition is condoned in the facts and circumstances of the case.

3. Learned counsel at the very outset submits that he

is not assailing the quantum of compensation awarded by the High Court. However, the petitioner is aggrieved by the direction contained in paragraph 15 of the impugned judgment, wherein, the petitioner has been directed to purchase medical insurance policy in the name of the mother, that is, the first claimant which would come into effect from the day she attains the age of 60 years.
