O R D E R

1. Issue notice, returnable in four weeks.
2. The State of Tamil Nadu is represented through counsel on advance notice. As such, no formal notice is required to be issued.
3. By way of *interim* order, in the event of arrest, the petitioners be released on bail in connection with F.I.R./Crime No.22 of 2026 date 29.01.2026 registered at Police Station Neyveli Township, District Cuddalore, Tamil Nadu, subject to their executing personal bonds for a sum of Rs.25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand Only) each, with one or more sureties in the like amount.

4. However, the petitioners are directed to cooperate with the investigation and report to the Investigating Officer as and when directed to do so.
