Similarly circumstanced co-accused persons have been granted bail by the High Court. Moreover, the petitioner is identically circumstanced as another co-accused Shreyansh Jhabak who has been granted bail by order dated 20.09.2021 passed by this Court.

In view of the order of this Court dated 20.09.2021 in Special Leave Petition(Cr1.) No. 5458/2021 (Shreyansh Jhabak vs. The State of Chhattisgarh), we deem it appropriate to grant interim bail to the petitioner on stringent conditions to be imposed by the Trial Court including but not limited to conditions with regard to sureties, bail bonds, etc. apart from reporting to the Investigating Authority on a regular basis, the petitioner shall not leave the jurisdiction of the Trial Court without leave of the Court.

The special leave petition is disposed of accordingly.
