O R D E R

The Court is convened through Video Conferencing.

Heard learned counsel appearing for the petitioner, learned Deputy Additional Advocate General appearing for the State of Madhya Pradesh and carefully perused the record.

Taking into consideration the fact that the petitioner is reported to have suffered incarceration for more than 4 years, all the main witnesses are reported to have already deposed before the Trial Court and there is no likelihood of completion of trial in the near future, which facts are not disputed by learned Deputy Additional Advocate General appearing for the State of M.P., we are inclined to grant bail to him.

The petitioner is, therefore, directed to be released on bail, subject to such terms and conditions which the concerned Trial Court shall deem fit and appropriate to impose upon them.

The Petitioner is directed to cooperate with the trial, not to interfere in the prosecution and also not to influence/threaten the witnesses in any manner whatsoever.

If the petitioner violates any of the said conditions, in addition to the conditions to be imposed by the Trial Court, the State would be at liberty to make a mention before us for cancellation of bail.

The Special Leave Petition and all the pending applications are disposed of in the afore-stated terms.
