UPON hearing counsel the Court made the following
O R D E R

There is a delay of 648 and 637 days respectively
in the filing of these two special leave petitions by
the Kerala State Toddy Shop Contractors Association and
by All India Toddy Tappers Workers Association. The
petitioners have sought to explain the delay by
submitting that they were not parties to the judgment and
the SLPs became necessary in view of the fact that it
affects a large number of persons.

On the facts and circumstances, we consider that
this is not a fit case for condonation of delay or to
grant permission.

We find that the order that is challenged in these
two SLPs is already under challenge in C.A. Nos.4039-
4053/2009. It is open to the petitioners to intervene in
C.A. Nos.4039-4053/2009.

Permission to file SLPs declined.
Special leave petitions are dismissed.
