O R D E RIA No.60561/2022

This is an application seeking exemption from surrendering. The petitioner stands convicted for the offence punishable u/s 354A (1)(i) of the IPC and sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for a period of one year. He is also convicted u/s 8 of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act and sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for three years and to pay a fine of Rs. 5000/-.

Taking note of the nature of the offences for which he was convicted and other relevant aspects, I am not inclined to allow this application.

In the said circumstances, the application stands rejected.

However, the petitioner is granted four weeks' time to surrender and produce proof of surrender.

List the matter before the appropriate Bench after processing and upon production of proof of surrender. In case of failure to proceed with the proof of surrender within the above stipulated time, list the matter for passing appropriate orders.
