Leave granted.

Having heard the learned counsel for the parties, we are not inclined to interfere with the impugned judgment insofar as the appellant, Ankur Jain, has been held guilty of committing contempt of court.

However, on the question of quantum of sentence, the appellant, Ankur Jain, has already undergone a sentence of imprisonment for a period of 45 days. It is also stated that the appellant, Ankur Jain, has been declared insolvent. It is further stated that the fine of ₹2000/- (Rupees two thousand only) has been paid.

On the submission made by the learned counsel for the respondent, it is stated on behalf of the appellant, Ankur Jain, that the companies, in which he has been a promoter or a shareholder or a director, would not press objections, if any, filed before the executing court claiming rights, title and interest in the property.

It is also noted that the appellant, Ankur Jain, is no longer in possession of the suit property.

In these circumstances, we reduce the sentence to the period of imprisonment already undergone and fine of ₹2000/- (Rupees two thousand only), as directed.

In view of the aforesaid discussion, we partly accept the present appeal, and reduce the sentence of imprisonment to the period undergone and ₹2000/- (Rupees two thousand only) as fine.

Accordingly, the appeal is disposed of.
