UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following  
O R D E R

1. While allowing interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner, we have observed that in the subject incident, petitioner has also suffered injuries which are mentioned in his MLR (Annexure A-1).

2. Learned State counsel informs that the petitioner has joined the investigation, and at the same time, he seeks opportunity to file additional counter affidavit.

3. Considering that there are cross-cases, by both the parties against each other, and the petitioner has also sustained injuries, we are not inclined to grant any further time to respondent-State to file additional counter affidavit.

4. On due consideration, we deem it appropriate to make absolute the interim order dated 24.02.2026. In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be enlarged on bail in connection with FIR No. 161 dated 22.11.2025 registered at Police Station Balachaur, District SBS Nagar, under Sections 115(2), 118(1), 3(5) & 118(2) of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS), 2023 on such terms and conditions as may be imposed by the Trial Court, subject to the condition that the petitioner shall continue to co-operate with the trial/ investigation.

5. Accordingly, the Special Leave Petition stands disposed of.

6. Pending applications(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
