O R D E R

The petitioner-a widow woman, who has the responsibility to maintain two children on her shoulders, seeks her enlargement on regular bail in a criminal case registered under Section 8(c), 20(b) and 29 of the Narcotics Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act (NDPS Act) vide F.I.R. No. 11196026210728/2021 dated 01.10.2021 in Police Station- Ravpura, District-Vadodara, Gujarat.

As per the allegations, 1 kg 285 gms of Ganja was recovered from the petitioner which is of intermediate quantity.

The petitioner is in custody for more than 08 months.

Though, the petitioner is involved in one more case under the NDPS Act in which she has been released on bail, we are satisfied that owing to her mitigating circumstances, the petitioner deserves the concession of bail.

The Petitioner is, accordingly, ordered to be released on bail subject to her furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Trial Court.

The Special Leave Petition is disposed of on the aforestated terms.
