Leave granted.

The appellant has challenged order dated 24.2.2014 passed by the High Court of Judicature at Allahabad in Criminal Appeal No. 1401 of 2012.

By

the impugned order, the Bail Application No. 63347 of 2013 preferred by the appellant was rejected.

Learned counsel for the appellant submits that the appellant has been sentenced to undergo imprisonment for ten years for the offence u/s 498A and 304B IPC and Dowry Prohibition Act. He is already in custody for more than six years and there is no likelihood of hearing of the appeal in near future.

Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case, we allow the prayer, set aside impugned order dated 24.2.2014 passed by the High Court of Judicature at Allahabad, suspend the sentence and direct that the appellant be released on bail subject to his furnishing bail bond of Rs.20,000/-(Rupees Twenty Thousand only) with two

solvent sureties for the like amount to the satisfaction of the Trial Court.
